Food Scores Index Definition Page

-  **Routine Score:** Initial Score for the facility at the time of the inspection.
-  **Corrected Score:** Score given after some violations have been corrected (after the routine score) at time of the routine inspection.
-  **Critical Violations:** Violations which, if not corrected, are more likely to directly contribute to food contamination, illness or unwholesomeness. Examples of critical violations include poor temperature control of food such as improper cooking, cooling, holding or reheating temperatures. Hygienic practices are also regarded as critical violations.
-  **Non-Critical Violations:** Non-critical violations do not directly relate to foodborne illness risk, but are preventive measures that include practices and procedures which effectively control environmental conditions. Examples of non-critical violations include: poor maintenance of nonfood-contact surfaces; improper storage and handling of clean equipment and utensils; various dumpster violations including failure to keep the lid closed or the drain plug in place; and cleaning of walls, floors, and ceilings.
-  **Follow- Up Score:** Score given after a re-inspection is performed to correct initial critical violations from the routine inspection.
-  **Verification:** A review of the facility food procedures and menu without the need of an inspection. Verifications only to apply to low risk facilities (Category III).
-  **N/A:** Not Applicable; a follow up inspection was not necessary and a score was not given; in case of verifications a score is not necessary.

Food Service (FS): A food establishment with more food preparation procedures than a retail food establishment. As an example, a grocery store selling only prepackaged food (Category III) in comparison to that same grocery store adding store made pizza and sandwiches making it a (FS) and Category II.
